Course Info: Approximately 5-mile loop, about 90% single track. Moderate amount of climbing. No pre-riding the course until the day of the race. The course is on private property, please do not jeopardize future races. If the weather is severe check www.teamharrisburg.com or call for race status.

Directions:

- From Harrisburg and points west: Take route 83 through Harrisburg to 322E. toward Hershey. Take the Hershey Park Drive exit. At the fourth light on Hershey Park Drive turn left onto Sand Beach Rd. (There will be a Turkey Hill on your right and the Hershey Outlets will be straight ahead.) Go over the hill and make a right onto Swatara Rd. It will be the first four way intersection you come to (but there is no stop sign in your direction.) Swatara House is the first brick house on the right side of the road-approx. 1/2 mile. Park on the left side of the road in the field.
- From points south: Take 743 N. through Hershey until it runs into Hershey Park Drive. You see Hershey Park on your left and there will be a Turkey Hill on the left at the light. Go straight through the intersection onto Sand Beach Rd. Follow the above directions where it says to go over the hill.
- From points north: Take 81 S. to the Rt. 39/Hershey exit. Follow 39 to Hershey Park Drive. Take a left on to Hershey Park Drive. At the second traffic light after the turn, take a left onto Sand Beach Rd. (there will be a Turkey Hill on the right) and follow the Harrisburg directions where it says to go over the hill.
- From the east: Take Rt. 322 into Hershey to Rt. 743 N. Turn right onto 743 N. and stay on 743 until it runs into Hershey Park Drive then follow the directions "from points south" provided above.
